Learning from Home – Updated Information

16th July 2021.

Dear Students and Parents,

I can confirm that learning from home has been extended for students in Greater Sydney until at least Friday 31st July 2021. The school will remain open to children of essential workers who require it. However, stay at home orders are in place and in response, the school will only have minimal supervision. Students who attend school will participate in online learning the same as the students learning from home. Please be advised the school uniform shop and canteen will be closed during this period of lock-down. Students will continue with the remote learning model, with students, where possible, participating in online learning using Google Classrooms. Students who attend school will need to follow the strict COVID safe practices, including physical distancing and wearing a mask or face covering.

We recognise the challenges associated with the current COVID situation, especially within our local community and would like to ensure our families that we will endeavour to make the learning and wellbeing needs of all students our primary focus. As we move into weeks 2 and 3, the **Learning from Home** model will change slightly to accommodate an increase in work we would like the students to complete.

Below you will find clarification about the Learning from Home model we will move into from Monday 19th July.

Learning from Home at Beverly Hills Girls High School for Years 7 to 10:

- Work will be provided to all students via Google Classroom. For Years 7 to 10, there is a separate Google Classroom where each day teachers will upload the work that is required to be completed. We are not working in class groups at this stage of our plan but as a whole year group.
- The Google Classroom codes are:

- The work provided will follow a similar format for Years 7 and 8. The students will have five tasks each day to complete. For example, on Monday the tasks will be English, Maths, PD/H/PE, CAPA and a wellbeing activity while on Tuesday the tasks will include Science, LOTE, Technology, HSIE and Wellbeing.
- The work provided for Years 9 and 10 will follow a similar format for both year groups. It involves completing five tasks including; three compulsory tasks and two elective tasks which the students will select from the elective pool. Optional/additional tasks can be completed. At the end of this letter you will find a table which shows the model.
- The students are expected to attempt all five tasks each day and submit as requested. Instructions will be given on the Google classroom on what each student is required to do. Teachers will be available via the Google Classroom or email if students wish to ask questions
- Each day when the student signs into their Google Classroom, they will need to complete the attendance question which will allow us to monitor student's engagement with online learning. Students will not need to follow their school timetable at this stage but try to complete the work whenever possible during the course of the day.
- The Google Classroom will be monitored by a team of teachers who will make contact with the students throughout the week. This will help us to support each of our students, with both their learning and wellbeing.

- **Learning from Home** at Beverly Hills Girls High School for Years 11 & 12:

Year 11 and 12 classes will continue with online learning through the class Goole Classrooms. All students need to log into the cohort's Google Classroom to view messages and answer the attendance question. To access the learning activities for the day students are required to go into their individual Google Classrooms set up by their classroom teachers.

Any student who can not access Google Classrooms from home, or has difficulty studying from home, will be permitted to attend school to do coursework, project work and exam preparations.

- Our school counsellors, school support officer, student advisors, careers advisor and members of the learning support team are working remotely and are still available to have phone consultations as required. Year 12 Trial HSC exams

- The school has decided to postpone the HSC trial exams for two weeks. Instead of the exams commencing in Week 2 Friday 23/7/21, they will now commence in Week 5 and continue into Week 6. We will be working on a new timetable for the HSC trial exams and will update information as it becomes available in the coming days. Students are encouraged to continue to study and work hard to revise, practise and seek feedback from their teachers.
- If students cannot be supervised at home and need to attend school the following applies:
 - Masks are mandatory in all indoor settings whilst at school. Students must wear a mask when using public transport. Parents will be contacted and asked to pick up their student if they refuse to wear a mask in doors
 - Bring their own food and drink as the canteen will not be open.
 - Students are required to meet our expectations in regards to wearing school uniform, punctuality and engagement.
 - Students who attend will be supervised in a learning space and given the same work as the students learning from home.
 - If students are, unwell they are not to attend school and if showing flu-like symptoms they will not be able to return to school until a negative COVID test result is presented.
 - Students who require a laptop to access their online learning can make a request through their Student Advisor. The computers will be on loan for the duration of the Lockdown.
